

## Art Disclosure Document-Painting

### **Course Description:**

This course will build upon the concepts learned in previous art classes however there is no prerequisite. Students will enlarge their art vocabulary, explore aesthetics, and use higher level thinking skills as they participate in art history, art criticism, and art production. We will emphasize skills and techniques used in drawing and painting. Quizzes and tests are a part of this curriculum. Homework is not often assigned but students can choose to work on their assignments at home as needed.

### **Class Expectations:**

- **Follow Directions.** All school rules will be followed in the classroom.
- **Come Prepared.** Bathroom stops and drinks of water will be taken care of before or after class.
- **No talking above a whisper.** You are in class to better your art skills and enhance your art experience, not to socialize. This allows for a productive and stress free learning environment.
- **Be respectful and Act Responsibly.** Everyone is to be treated with respect. You are responsible for your own actions. You will be respectful of the art materials and responsible for them.
- **No cell phones, food, or drinks in class. Gum is okay as long as it stays in the mouth!**

### **Discipline Policy:**

Self control is imperative in an art class. **Students must demonstrate responsibility for appropriate handling of art materials and equipment at all times.** Failure to do so will result in restrictions from use of materials or from art class in general. If behavior continues after student receives a warning he/she will be removed from class and parents will be notified. There is no room for horseplay of any kind.

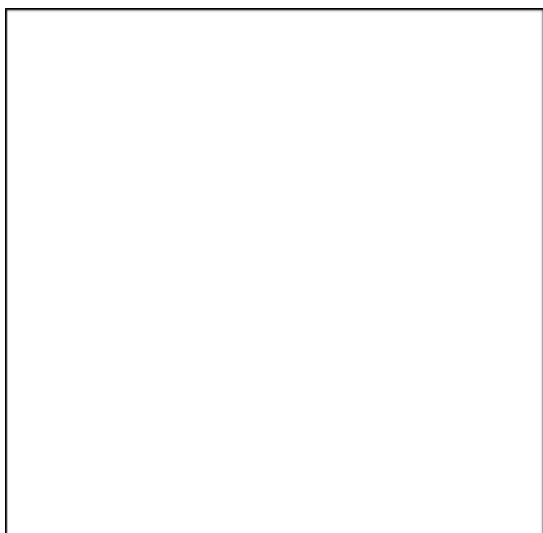

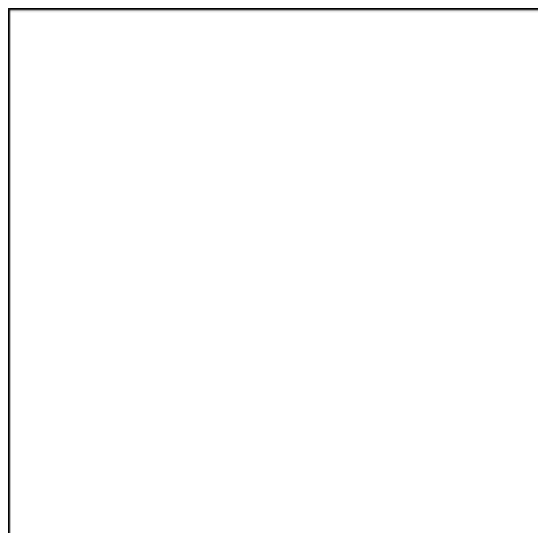

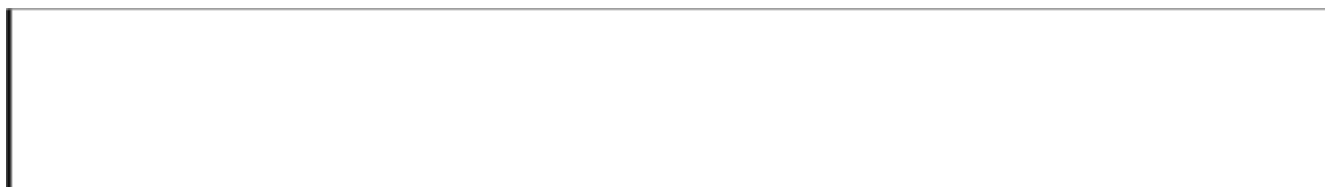
